Cyber Threats Unmasked: Scam Trends and Protection Strategies in the Philippines and Southeast Asia

In an increasingly digital world, cyber threats have become more sophisticated and widespread—making awareness and preparedness more crucial than ever. To help students and the community stay informed and protected, SISFU hosted a Cybersecurity Masterclass titled “Cyber Threats Unmasked: Scam Trends and Protection Strategies in the Philippines and Southeast Asia.”

The session, held on November 4, 2025, at the SISFU Multipurpose Hall and streamed online, featured Ms. Mel Migriño, PH Country Head & General Manager / Regional Director for Information Security at Gogolook (Whoscall). A renowned expert in the field, Ms. Migriño shared valuable insights into the latest scam trends affecting the Philippines and Southeast Asia, emphasizing the importance of vigilance and proactive protection in an increasingly connected society.

Throughout the two-hour session, participants learned how to identify red flags, prevent potential breaches, and strengthen their digital resilience. The talk highlighted real-world examples of online scams, the psychology behind cyberattacks, and practical steps individuals can take to secure their digital presence.

The masterclass served as a reminder that cybersecurity is not just a technical concern but a shared responsibility among all digital citizens. Through education and awareness, students are empowered to protect themselves and their communities from emerging online threats.

By the end of the event, attendees left with a deeper understanding of the cyber landscape—and a renewed commitment to practicing safe and responsible online behavior.

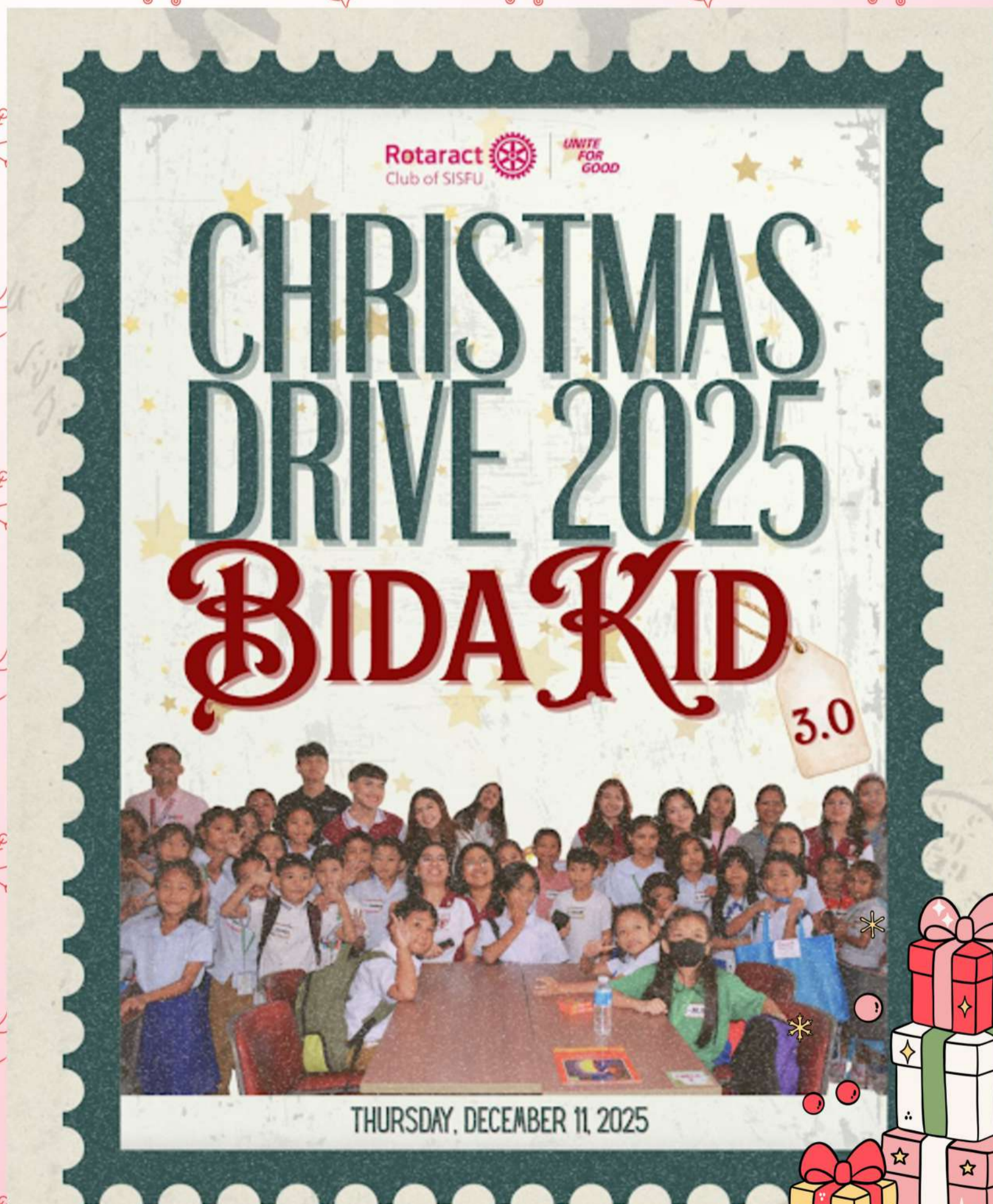

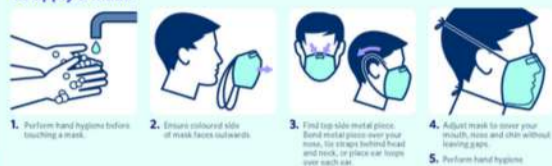
