TERM 1 CSN SET FOR RELEASE ON OCTOBER 10



The Class Standing Notice (CSN) is an important tool designed to provide both students and parents with a clear understanding of academic progress in each subject. It not only reflects current performance but also serves as a guide for improvement, accountability, and support. By monitoring class standing regularly, students are reminded that learning is a process—one that requires effort, responsibility, and consistency.

- **On-Target** – The student has complied with all subject requirements, and the current grade ranges from satisfactory to outstanding. This status reflects consistency, diligence, and responsibility in meeting academic expectations.
- **At Risk** – The student has incomplete requirements and/or the current grade is fairly satisfactory. This status indicates the need for greater effort, timely submission of tasks, and stronger focus to reach the expected level of performance.
- **Delayed** – The student has missing or incomplete requirements, and the current grade did not meet expectations. This status calls for immediate attention and intervention to catch up and get back on track.

The purpose of the Class Standing Notice is not to discourage, but to empower. It allows students to recognize their strengths, address their areas for improvement, and take ownership of their learning journey. For parents, it serves as a communication bridge to better understand their child's academic standing and to provide guidance and encouragement at home.

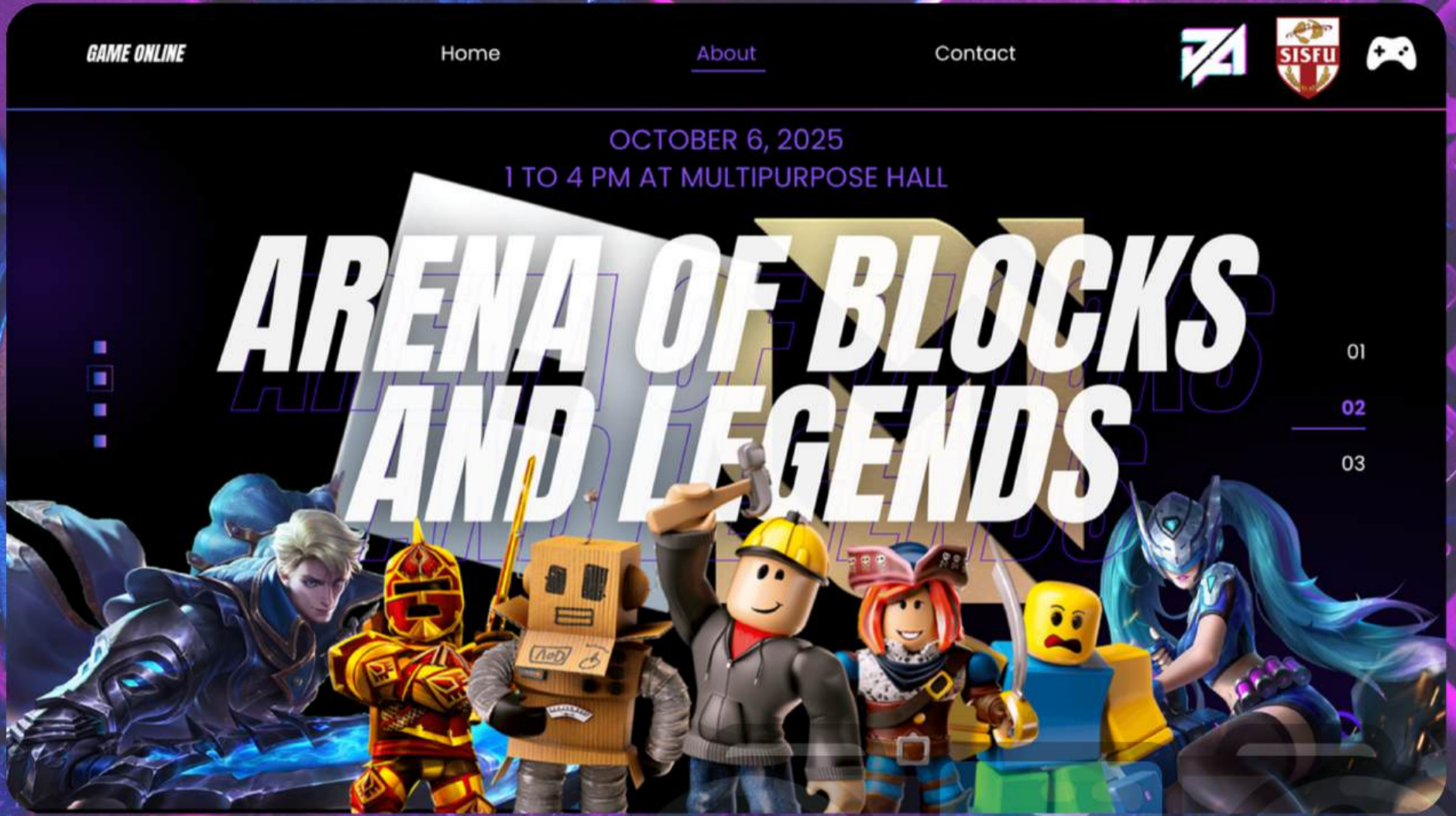

Beyond Words: Building Connections that Matter

Why it Matters: In his TEDx talk, Pellegrino Riccardi reminds us that “Culture is not about what you say, it’s about what you mean.” In today’s interconnected world, success in school, relationships, and future careers depends on more than knowledge—it depends on how well we understand, respect, and connect with people from different backgrounds. By practicing socio-emotional skills, we can bridge cultural gaps, reduce misunderstandings, and create a safe and inclusive environment for everyone.

SEL Focus Skills

- **Cultural Awareness** – Recognize that people may see, feel, and express things differently based on their culture.
- **Empathy Across Differences** – Listen with the intent to understand, not just to reply.
- **Respectful Curiosity** – Ask questions to learn, not to judge.
- **Adaptability** – Adjust communication styles depending on context and audience.
- **Global Responsibility** – Understand how your choices and words affect not only those near you but also those in the wider world.

Practical Tips for Students

- **Pause Before Assuming** – Different cultures may interpret the same words or gestures differently. Take time to clarify.
- **Show Respect Through Listening** – Give your full attention and avoid interrupting, even if you disagree.
- **Celebrate Differences** – Instead of seeing diversity as a barrier, treat it as an opportunity to learn something new.
- **Use Inclusive Language** – Choose words that make everyone feel welcome and valued.
- **Be Open to Feedback** – If someone corrects your cultural misunderstanding, accept it as a chance to grow and build stronger connections.

Leptospirosis: Know the Signs, Stay Safe

Leptospirosis is a bacterial infection commonly spread through water contaminated by the urine of infected animals, especially rodents. Symptoms may include high fever, headache, abdominal pain, diarrhea, vomiting, rash, red eyes, muscle pain, jaundice, and cold-like signs. Early medical attention is crucial to prevent severe complications.

The Eisenhower matrix: How to work more efficiently

- **Prioritize important tasks first** – Focus on assignments or reviews that impact your grades most before tackling minor tasks.
- **Set deadlines for urgent work** – Manage urgent but less important tasks by scheduling and sticking to deadlines.
- **Plan ahead to avoid last-minute stress** – Break projects into smaller steps and allocate them into your schedule early.
- **Learn to say no** – Avoid distractions or commitments that aren't important to your studies.
- **Delegate or simplify when possible** – For group work, assign responsibilities so tasks don't pile up on one person.
- **Review and adjust weekly** – Regularly recheck your tasks using the matrix to stay on track with priorities.





DISASTER READINESS AND RISK REDUCTION



READINESS DURING DISASTER

EARTHQUAKE SAFETY

DROP

Drop to the ground and do the cover position



COVER

Look for a sturdy cover and go under it



HOLD

Hold tight until the shaking stops



EARTHQUAKE DRILL FLOW

Alarm → Drop-Cover-Hold
Evacuate → Assembly Area
Headcount & Report
Simulate First Aid / Hazards
Stay outside for aftershocks
Debrief & Improve

- Stay updated: Follow PHIVOLCS & LGU advisories
- Don't re-enter buildings until inspected

AFTER EARTHQUAKE

- Check injuries & hazards
- Evacuate to open space
- Stay away from damaged buildings & power lines
- Move to higher ground if tsunami alert is issued



VOLCANIC ERUPTION



EVACUATE

Seek for evacuation centers when alert levels reach your place



SEND HELP

Help others whenever you can



SUPPLIES

Bring the basic needs with you like food, water, and first aid kit



BE UPDATED

Listen for the updates regarding the situation, so you can act accordingly

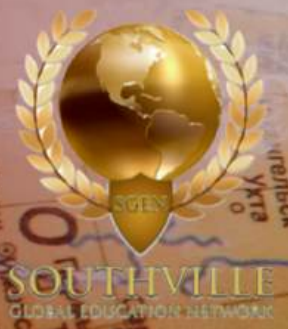
